About This Report

Each year, the Municipality of Brockton and Bruce County partner to conduct a regional visitor survey, gathering valuable insights from people traveling throughout the area. The goal of this survey is to support tourism agencies, businesses, and local decision-makers by providing data that helps guide strategic planning and investment.

This report highlights data from the 2024 survey specific to visitors who indicated that they spent time in a community within Brockton. It's important to note that while these visitors did visit Brockton, their spending and accommodation choices may have occurred elsewhere in the region.

In 2024, a total of 1,645 surveys were completed. Of those, 225 respondents reported visiting a community in Brockton during their stay.

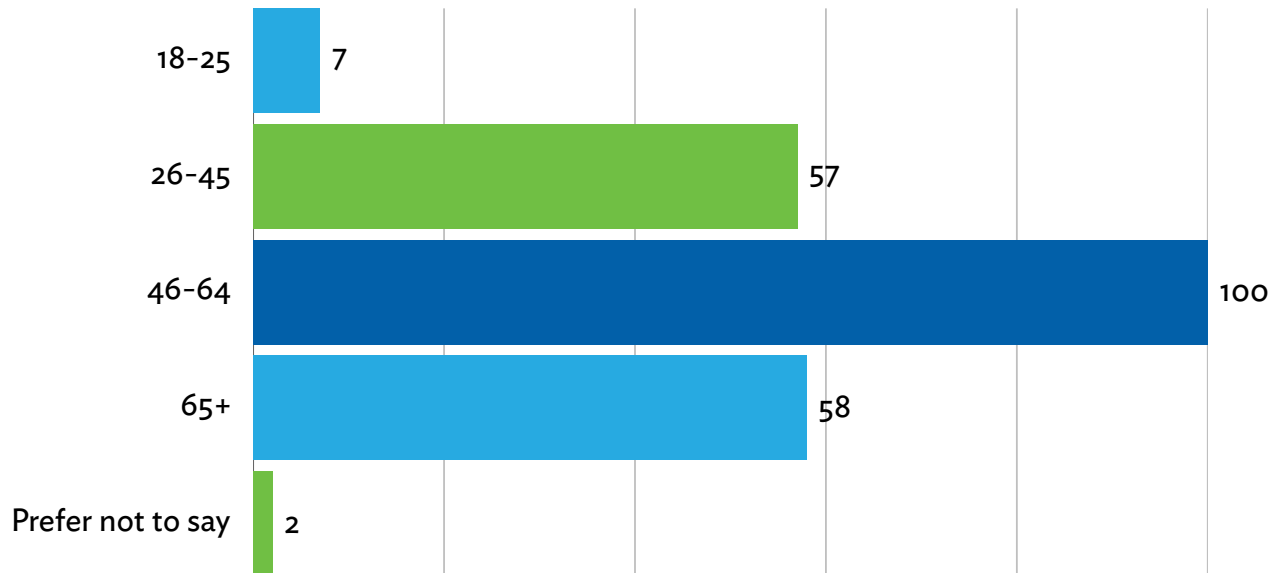
ABOUT THE SURVEY:

Most questions contained within the survey were optional, and many allowed for multiple responses; as such, the number of responses may not equal the total number of respondents.

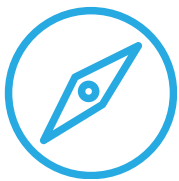


Visitor Demographics

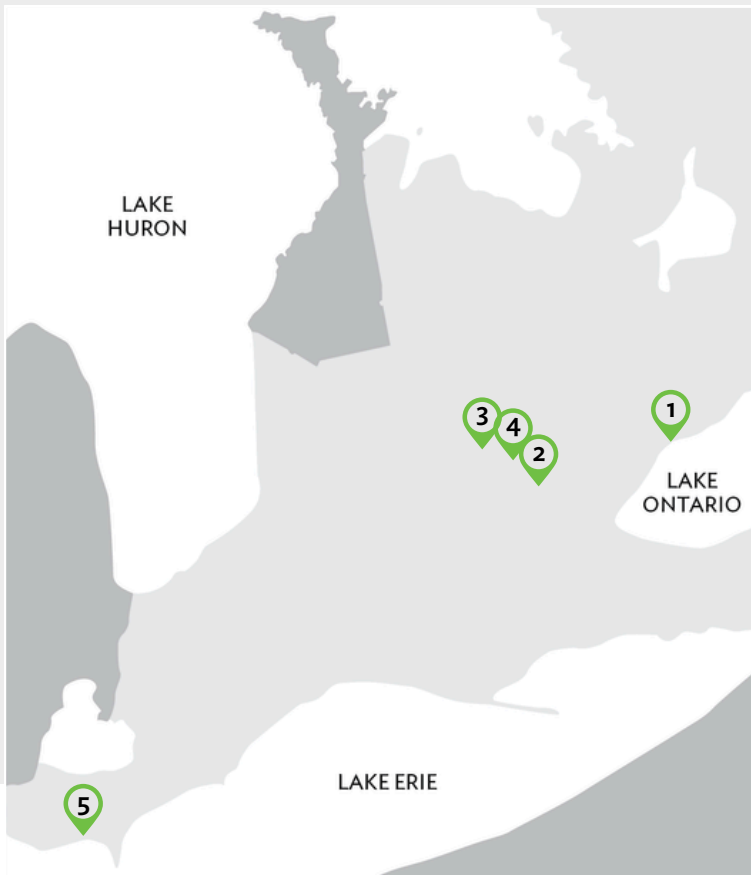

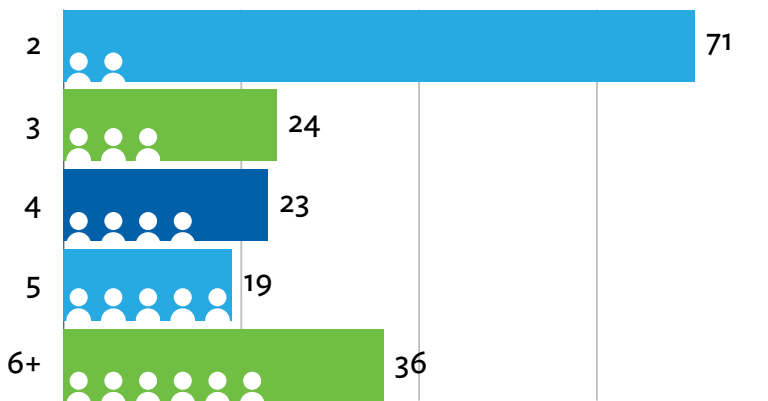


Where the Most Frequent Out-of-County Visitors Are From

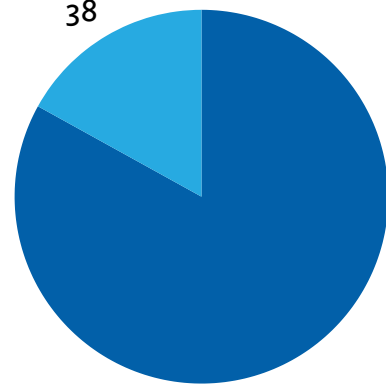

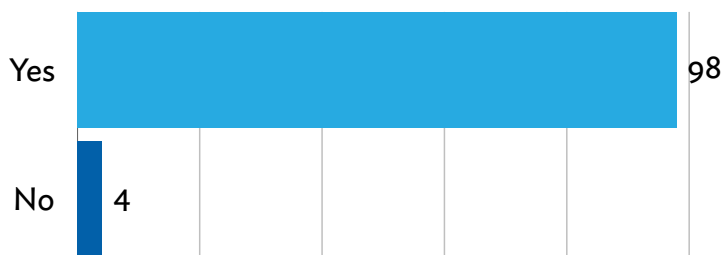

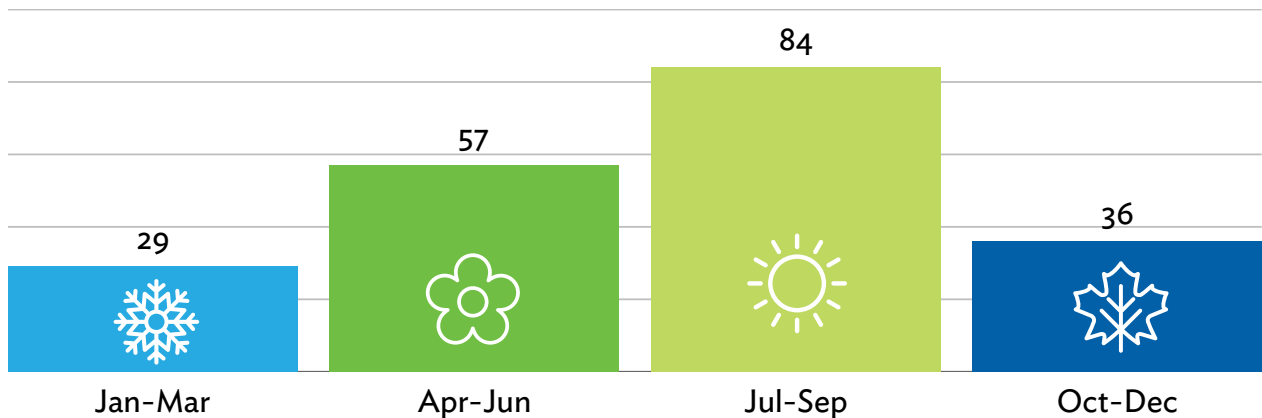
Visitation Patterns

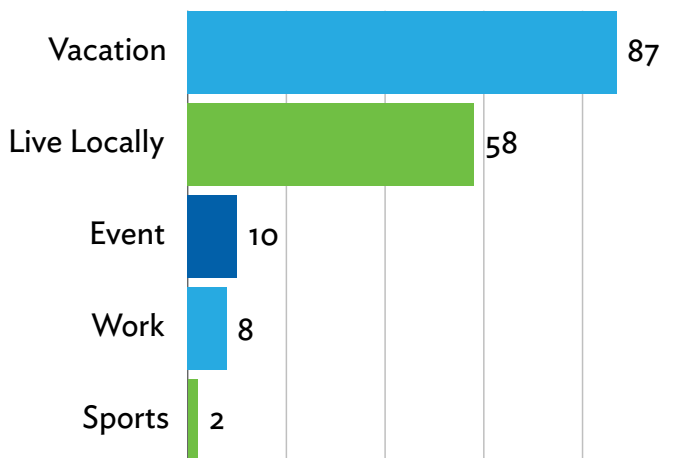

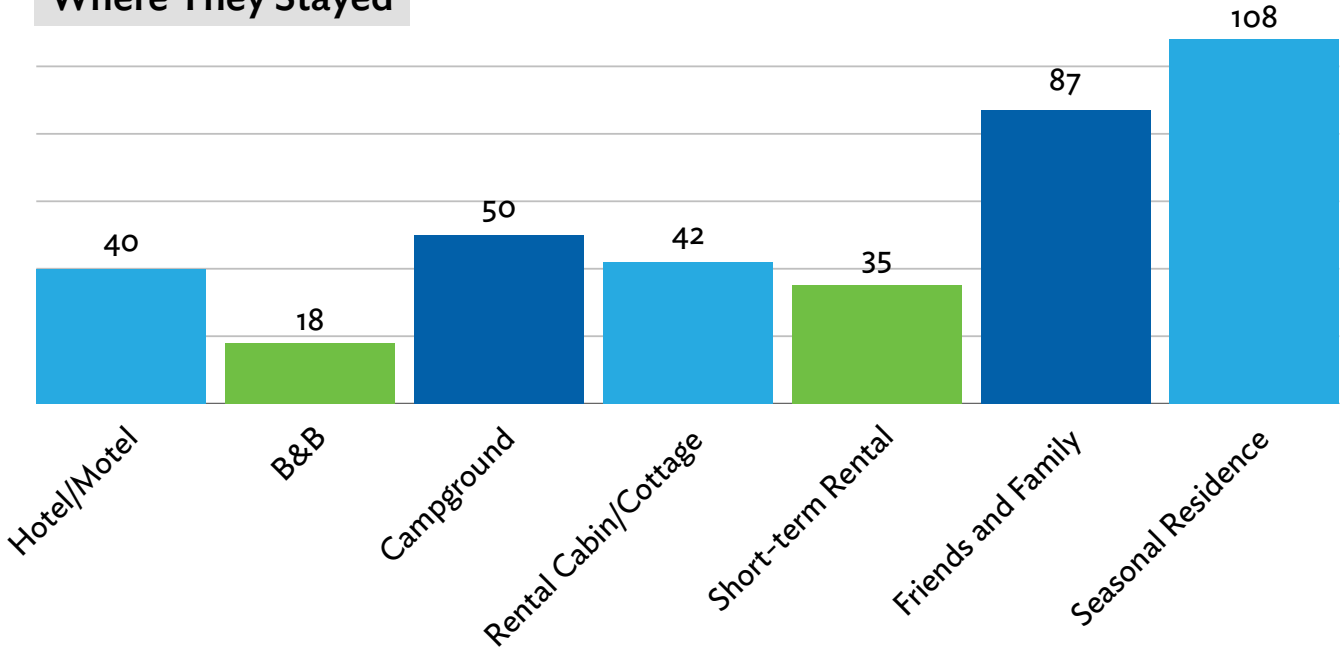

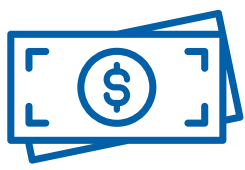

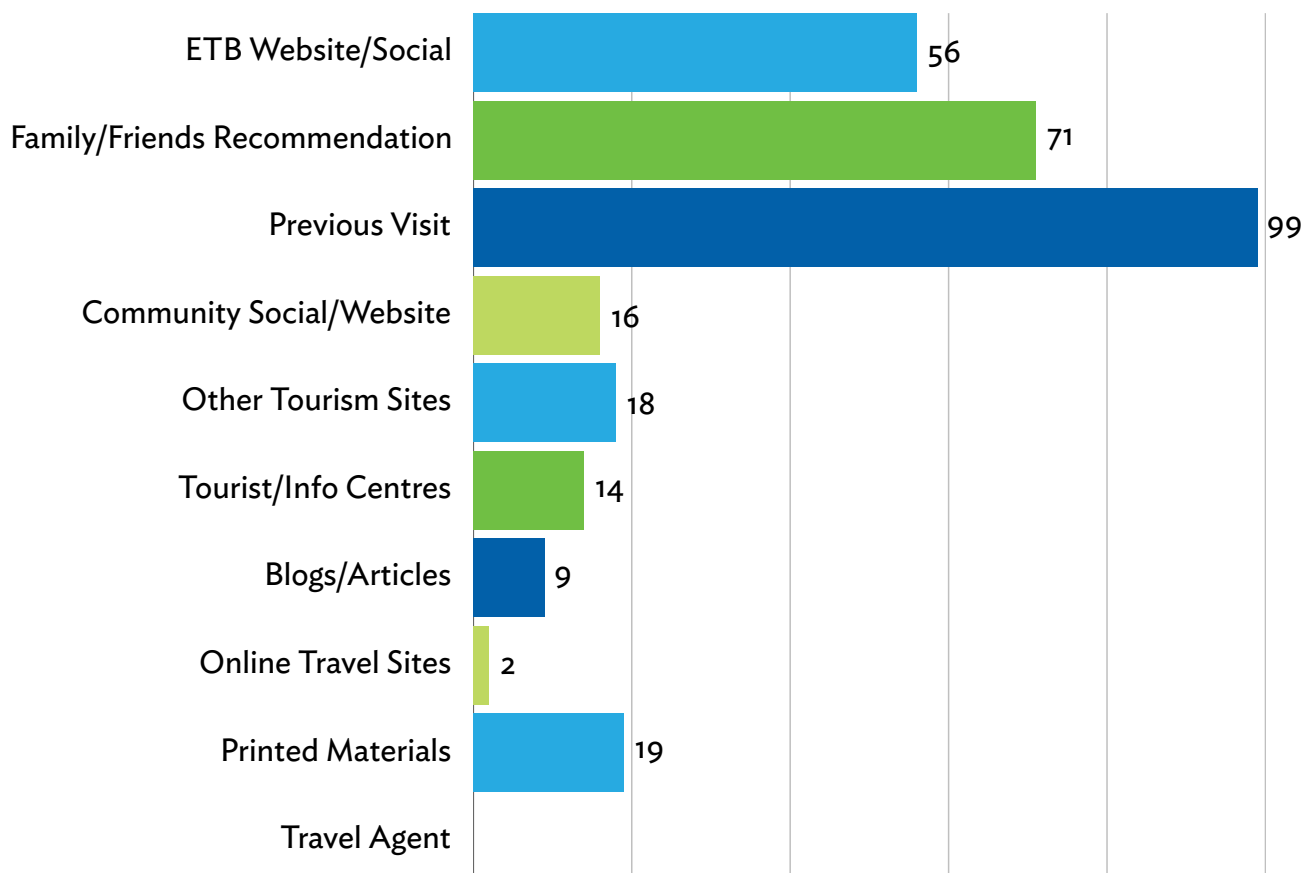

How Far in Advance Their Trip Planning Started



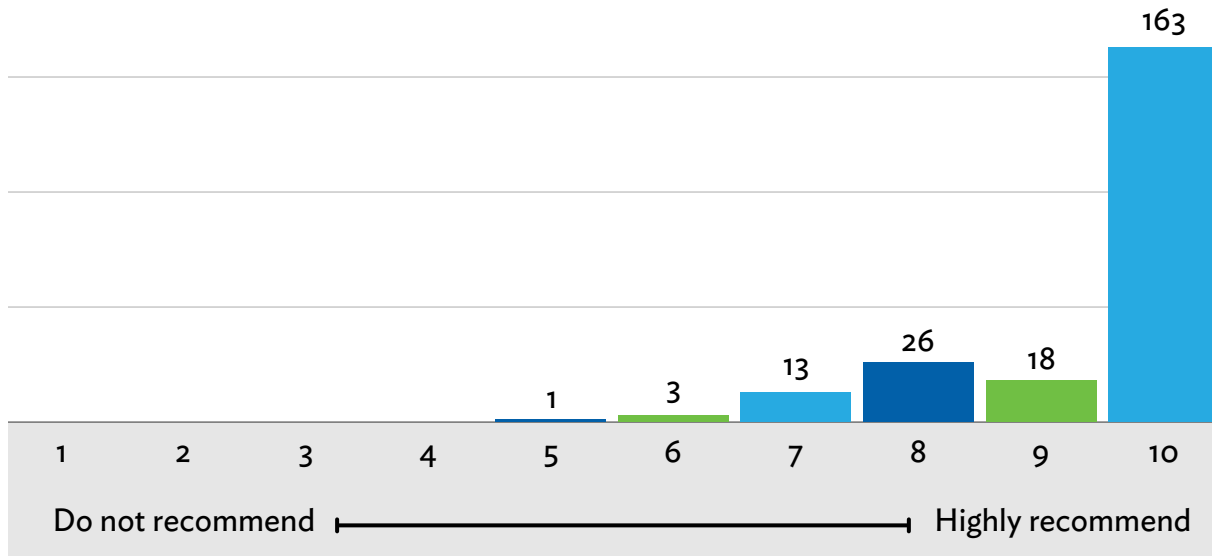

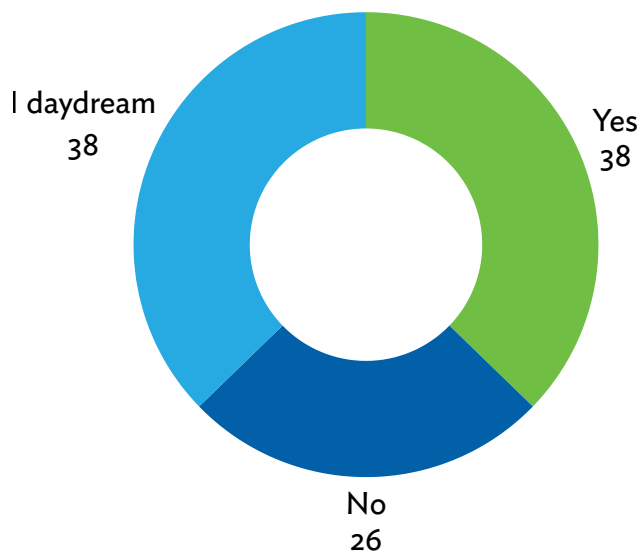
